

Information about personal data processing on the website <https://gaminginpoland.pl>

The aim of the Controller is to duly inform the Users of the website <https://gaminginpoland.pl> about the scope of personal data processing on the website. The Controller makes every effort to ensure safety and confidentiality of personal data, to which he has access as a result of you using the website <https://gaminginpoland.pl>.

Below please find information about personal data processed on the website <https://gaminginpoland.pl>, purposes of and grounds for their processing, your rights regarding personal data protection, measures and methods used to secure data and information about the use of Cookies, required pursuant to the contents of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

Who is the personal data controller?

The Controller of the personal data is Gaming in Poland spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością with its registered office in Wrocław (53-033), ul. Zwycięska 20a/204 entered into Register of Entrepreneurs of National Register Court maintained by the District Court for the Wrocław - Fabryczna in Wrocław VI Commercial Division of the National Register Court under the no. KRS 0000759388, NIP (Tax Identification Number), 8971861619, REGON: 381885664.

What is the purpose of personal data processing?

The purposes of the Controller and scope of data processing depend on the consent given by the User. The Controller processes User data, in particular to:

- answer the questions sent via the contact form available at <https://gaminginpoland.pl/contact-us> and
- sending a newsletter via the e-mail address provided.

What are the grounds for personal data processing?

In case of sending a question via a contact form available at <https://gaminginpoland.pl/contact-us>, and in the case of subscribing to the newsletter personal data processing is based on Article 6 section 1 letter a) of the GDPR, i.e. granted consent.

Who is the recipient of the personal data?

Personal data of the User may be received by entities providing services for the Controller, including in particular IT services (also hosting services).

What are your rights connected to personal data processing by the Controller?

In order to protect his/her rights the User is entitled to:

- 1) access the contents of data;
- 2) rectify the data;
- 3) delete the data;
- 4) restrict the data processing;
- 5) transfer the data.

Given that data processing takes place based on a consent, you also have the right to withdraw the consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. All rights that you have in connection to data processing that are related to you may be executed by sending a relevant demand via the contact

form available at the website or to the email address office@gaminginpoland.pl You also have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if you consider that the data processing breaches the personal data protection regulations.

Is the provision of personal data voluntary?

The provision of personal data is voluntary. But it is necessary to use the contact form.

Are the personal data profiled and/or automatically processed?

Your data will not be automatically processed and will not be profiled.

Are the personal data transferred to a third country?

Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or international organization outside the European Economic Area.

Does the website use cookies?

The website <https://gaminginpoland.pl> uses only Cookies which are intended to ensure functionality of the website. Information gathered with the use of Cookies are not used for marketing or advertising purposes and are not transferred to third parties. The used Cookies are session files and do not use the collected data after exiting the website <https://gaminginpoland.pl>. You can change Cookies settings in the options of Internet browser that you use.

What measures and methods of personal data protection are used by the Controller?

Taking into account the nature, scope, context and purposes of processing as well as the risks of varying likelihood and severity for the rights and freedoms of natural persons, the Controller implements appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the User's personal data protection.

The Controller in particular uses measures guaranteeing:

- 1) prevention of access of unauthorized persons to the personal data;
- 2) prevention of processing in breach of the applicable provisions of law;
- 3) personal data protection against loss, damage or destruction.
